Recommended Action:

Approval of the replat for Dansville Phase 6 located in Section 8, Township 30 South, Range 15 East.

- The property is located south of Pine Street, west of Oak Street and to the north of 132nd Avenue North.

- The site is being subdivided into 11-single family lots and dedicated public right of way.

Pinellas County purchased these lots after a storm destroyed many homes in the Dansville Community. Dansville Phase 6 is the final phase of re-platting by Pinellas County in this community. The purchase and re-platting were to provide uniform streets and blocks for better redevelopment of the community.
