**Recommended Action:**

Approval of the award of bid to Suncoast Development of Pinellas County, Inc. (Suncoast) for the 49<sup>th</sup> Street at 38<sup>th</sup> Avenue North Intersection Improvements Project (Project).

- The Project consists of intersection improvements that include road reconstruction, turn lane improvements, milling and resurfacing, stormwater improvements, sidewalk, curb and mast arms to replace existing concrete strain poles.
- Six bids were received with Suncoast recommended for award as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in the amount of \$1,176,249.90.
- All work will be completed with three hundred consecutive calendar days.
- The Project is budgeted/funded 100% by Multimodal Impact Fees.
- The Small Business Enterprise goal is thirteen percent for this contract.

Contract No. 21-0043-CP(PLU); PID No. 000958A; in the amount of \$1,176,249.90; all work will be completed within 300 consecutive calendar days. Authorize the Chairman to sign and the Clerk of the Circuit Court to attest.
