This Amendment extends the agreement for three (3) months through June 28, 2021, to allow for the evaluation, and award of a new contract.

The purpose of this contract is to provide a mechanical, electrical and plumbing engineering, technical, and construction management services to support numerous projects identified in the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP).

Background/Explanation:

This contract was competitively solicited and awarded by the Board of County Commissioners on March 29, 2016. The County Administrator approved Amendment No. 1 to acknowledge a corporate name change with TLC on June 15, 2020.

Fiscal Impact:

This Amendment has no monetary impact to the contract.

Approved to date upset limit over the five (5) year term of the contract is \$500,000.00 for each firm for a total of \$4,000,000.00.

Total upset limit through June 30, 2021; \$500,000.00 for each firm for a total of \$4,000,000.00.

Seventy-five percent (75%) of funding is derived from various CIP budgets and twenty-five percent (25%) is derived from operating budgets per individual work assignments on a multiple year/multiple work assignment basis.
