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### **Subject:**

Authority to advertise a public hearing for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2018-2019 Annual Action Plan for federal funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

### **Summary:**

In accordance with 24 CFR 91, Pinellas County must submit an Annual Action Plan which identifies specific projects and activities to be undertaken each year to address the needs identified in the Five-Year Consolidated Plan and further the identified priorities and strategies. The Action Plan contains the application for HOME Investment Partnership (HOME), Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds.

The purpose of the public hearing is to receive comments, suggestions, and views on the proposed FY 2018-2019 Action Plan. In addition to the public hearing a 30-day public comment period was held to solicit input on the Action Plan.

The deadline for submission of the FY 2018-2019 Action Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is August 16, 2018. The recommended public hearing date of June 19, 2018 allows sufficient time to prepare the materials necessary for submission.
