Petition of Eastern Shores Holdings, LLC to vacate a portion of a platted right-of-way on Lots 14 through 16 and on the north of the south line of Lot 17, Riverside Farms, Plat Book 3, Page 16 in Section 2-27-15, Pinellas County, Florida (legislative hearing).

Summary:

The subject petition seeks to vacate approximately 1,486 square feet of right-of-way (10' x 148.6'), bounded on the south by the north line of Lots 14 thru 16 and bounded on the north by the south line of Lot 17, Riverside Farms, Plat Book 3, Page 16. The petitioner is seeking to vacate the alley to allow for the release of an encroachment of a building.

Background Information:

County departments were queried and have no objection to the vacation of the alley. There are no County utilities within the subject portion of the alley.

Letters of no objection were received from Bright House, City of Tarpon Springs, Duke Energy, Frontier, Pinellas County Utilities, TECO Electric, TECO Peoples Gas and WOW!

The petition was properly advertised in accordance with Florida State Statute 336. Pursuant to the Real Property Division Procedures, notices were mailed by the Clerk of the Court to property owners

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within two hundred feet of the subject property and three neighborhood notification signs were placed. The Deputy Clerk will report to the Board any citizen support or opposition.
