Subject:

Resolution approving B7082957753 as a Qualified Applicant for the Qualified Target Industry Tax Refund Program.

Recommended Action

Adopt a resolution approving B7082957753 as a qualified applicant pursuant to Section 288.106, Florida Statutes, and identify sources of local County financial support of Project B7082957753 as local participation in the Qualified Target Industry Tax Refund Program.

Summary:

Project B7082957753 is a manufacturing business enterprise that would like to expand its operations into Pinellas County, with both job creation and capital investment components.

Background Information:

Project B7082957753 is a manufacturing business enterprise that would like to expand their operations into Pinellas County. The economic impact of the project's capital investment is \$2.8M. An estimated 20 employees are projected to be hired with annual pay scales of at least 150% of the average annual wage for the State of Florida, which is \$45,562.00. These earnings would result in an economic impact of \$2 million and a total of 36 direct and indirect new jobs. Additional sites the company is considering are in Georgia, North Carolina and Canada.

The economic impacts were calculated using the U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis Regional Input Modeling System (RIMS II) Model for Pinellas County.

Fiscal Impact:

The total tax refund is \$120,000.00 which is calculated at \$6,000.00 per job with a total of 20 new jobs. The \$6,000.00 per job calculation is based on pay scales of at least 150% of the State of Florida's average annual wage, and a high impact sector bonus. This incentive returns a portion of taxes paid by the business after the company meets its job creation and wage commitments. Additionally, no more than 25% of the total refund approved may be taken in any single fiscal year.

Florida Statute requires 20% local financial participation as tax refunds become due. Project B7082957753 is requesting the Board of County Commissioners to provide 50% of the local match necessary to facilitate the State approval process, with the City of Pinellas Park providing the additional 50%. The total local financial support requested is \$24,000.00 of which \$12,000.00 (50% of the local match) is being requested through Pinellas County Government and will be budgeted within the Department of Economic Development through the general fund. The tax refund will be paid over a series of fiscal years as determined by the State.
