### **Recommended Action:**

Approval of the award of bid to Suncoast Development of Pinellas County, Inc. (Suncoast) for the Fiscal Year 2020-2022 Countywide ADA, sidewalk, drainage, and roadway improvements.

- The purpose of this contract is to construct sidewalk, drainage, roadway and ADA improvements in support of the roadway resurfacing program.
- Two bids were received with an award recommendation to the lowest responsive responsible bid, Suncoast, in the amount of \$14,364,444.00.
- All work is expected to be completed within 830 consecutive calendar days.
- Suncoast is certified as a Pinellas County Small Business Enterprise.

Bid No. 189-0509-CP(PLU); PID No. 004184A; in the amount of \$14,365,444.00 as the lowest responsive, responsible bid received meeting specifications. Authorize the Chairman to sign and the Clerk of the Court to attest.
