Subject:

Appointment of an alternate to the Historic Preservation Board (Board of County Commissioners as a whole).

Recommended Action:

Approve one appointment as an alternate to the Historic Preservation Board for a 3-year term ending December 31, 2024.

- Ballot/worksheet is provided; however, the Clerk may request a verbal vote.

Background Information:

The Historic Preservation Board is comprised of nine members and two alternate members, who each serve a three-year term. Each member of the BCC nominates one member, and the BCC jointly nominates two at-large members and two alternates. The BCC also appoints one County Commissioner to the Historic Preservation Board to serve as its Chairman and ex-officio, non-voting member. The HPB must be composed of community advocates, municipal representatives, and historic preservation professionals with expertise and/or knowledge in the historic preservation field. Section 146-4, Pinellas County Code, also states that the Board include at least two members who are not required to have expertise or knowledge in the historic preservation.
