**Background Information:**

The Council was created by Chapter 80-585, Laws of Florida, and is made up of 24 members that constitute a broad spectrum of county representation. Of the 24, four (4) members are selected by the Pinellas County Mayors' Council pending ratification by the EMSA. It is the responsibility of EMSAC to fulfill the objectives outlined in the bylaws under Article II, Section 2.1.
