Subject:

Housing Finance Authority of Pinellas County: 2018 Annual Report.

Recommended Action:

Recommend the Board of County Commissioners receive and file the 2018 Annual Report on the Housing Finance Authority of Pinellas County.

- During 2018, the HFA's First-Time Homebuyer Program served 117 families, all families utilized the down payment assistance program and were at or below 80% of the Area Median Income (AMI).
- The HFA continued to administer the Neighborhood Stabilization Programs (NSP) under contract with Pinellas County. The Specific Performance Agreements related to NSP 1 and 3 were terminated in 2018 since all funds have been exhausted and all subject properties were rehabbed or constructed. Under the NSP 2 program 22 vacant lots await new construction and 2 homes were sold to homebuyers earning below 120% of the AMI.
- The HFA closed on two Multi-Family housing developments in 2018, with the 8 previous developments continuing to operate at high vacancy rates (90% and above).
- The HFA continued to administer the Penny for Pinellas Land Assembly Fund (LAF) on behalf of the County to finance 5 projects for a total investment of \$4,894,334.26.
